The Bristol Virginia School Board met in Regular Session on Monday, May 09, 2022, in the Bristol Virginia Public Schools Administration Office, 280 Lee Street, Bristol, Virginia. A quorum was present with the following Board members in attendance:

Mr. Randy Alvis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. He welcomed all in attendance and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Alvis asked for a motion to approve the Agenda. Mr. Frank Goodpasture so moved. Mr. Steve Fletcher seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Alvis addressed Item 2 (A) Bearcat Best – Nurse Department. Dr. Keith Perrigan, Superintendent and School Board Members recognized employees of the Nursing Department for their dedication and exemplary service to Bristol Virginia Public Schools.

Mr. Alvis addressed Item 2 (B) Recognition of Bearcat Elite. Dr. Perrigan and School Board Members recognized students from the Art department for their outstanding work.

Mr. Alvis addressed Item 3 (C) Superintendent’s Report. Dr. Perrigan noted all documents have been submitted and edited for the loan closing on the new school. Once the bonds are sold and closing completed, we will be ready to begin the project. We are currently working with the City to get final approval of the civil plans so we can start to move dirt! Committees have already begun work to ensure that we have a seamless transition on Day 1. He added we have had a lot of great news recently! He noted we obviously recognized some amazing artists this evening. Dr. Perrigan added the following highlights, our SOL scores are coming in and they are the best we have experienced in recent years, Madyson Fleenor, Class of 2021 won the Tennessee State Collegiate Competition for Auto Mechanics, a group of students at Virginia High School won the Southwest Region Stock Market Game, virtually earning over \$108,000.00, and Personal Finance students at Virginia High School were in the top 10 in the nation in performance on the Wi\$e Financial Test. He added our Community was recognized as a Top Community in the Nation for Music Education.

Mrs. Forbes-Hubbard seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.


The Board went into Closed Session at 6:58 p.m.
