Mr. Randy Alvis, Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. He welcomed all in attendance and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Alvis asked for a motion to approve the Agenda. Mr. Frank Goodpasture so moved. Mrs. Breanne Forbes-Hubbard seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Alvis addressed Item 2 (A) Recognition of 2021-2022 Retirees. Dr. Keith Perrigan, Superintendent and School Board Members recognized Dr. Linda V. Mr. Alvis addressed Item 4 (B) International Baccalaureate Presentation. Mr. Gary Ritchie, Assistant Superintendent presented a detailed PowerPoint outlining the differences in IB and DE classes. Including the savings for families, college costs, student participation, courses taken in pursuit of an Associates Degree, and courses taken in pursuit of an Associates Degree with opportunity to take an IB course.
