Criteria for Awarding Local Credit

For purposes of determining whether a student qualifies for locally awarded credit in science and/or social studies, a local review panel will review evidence of the student's academic achievement on Standards of Learning objectives in those specific areas.

The review panel will be approved by the School Board and will consist of the following representatives from the high school staff:

- One social studies teacher,
- One science teacher,
- One guidance counselor, and
- Two school administrators.

The review panel shall certify that

- The student meets the requirements under policy IKFA, and
- The student earned a course grade of "C" or better in the course for which the student is applying for locally awarded credit.

The review panel shall notify the Superintendent of those students who qualify for locally awarded credit under policy **IKFA**.
