

**REVOCATION OF STUDENT MOTOR
VEHICLE PRIVILEGES FOR NON-ATTENDANCE**

Each student shall comply with the compulsory school attendance law of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the policy and regulations of the Bristol Virginia Public Schools on the subject of school attendance, tardiness, and period attendance.

In the event that any student fails to comply with such law, policy and/or regulations, then that student shall not have the privilege of driving a motor vehicle on the property of the Bristol Virginia Schools and shall not park a vehicle on said property. Any parking privileges that may have been granted to such a student shall be revoked, and the prohibition against driving and parking on school property shall be effective for the remainder of the school year.

At the conclusion of each grading period, the principal shall forward to the Office of the Superintendent a list of students who have failed to comply with the previously-referenced law, policy and/or regulations, and the Superintendent, or his designee, shall communicate in writing to the student and his parents or guardian the fact of the prohibition and/or revocation of driving and parking privileges.
