Dr. Keith Perrigan, Superintendent called the Re-Organizational Meeting to order and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dr. Perrigan asked for a motion to elect the School Board Chair for 2018-2019. Mr. Ronald Cameron nominated Mr. Randy Alvis to serve as Bristol Virginia School Board Chair for 2018-2019. Mr. Tyrone Foster seconded the motion, and Mr. Randy Alvis was elected unanimously to serve as Bristol Virginia School Board Chair for 2018-2019.

Mr. Alvis, Chair, asked for a motion to elect the School Board Vice Chair for 2018-2019. Mr. Foster nominated Mr. Steve Fletcher to serve as Bristol Virginia School Board Vice Chair for 2018-2019. Mr. Fletcher seconded the motion, and Mrs. Stephanie Austin was elected unanimously to serve as Bristol Virginia School Board Deputy Clerk for 2018-2019.

Mr. Alvis asked for a motion to select a Board Representative to the Governor's School Board. Mr. Foster nominated Mr. Fletcher to serve as the Board Representative to the Governor's School Board. Mr. Cameron seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
