

Repeating Courses for Credit

A student may repeat a high school level course for credit, to the extent that his/her schedule will allow. When a student repeats a high school level course for a credit during the regular academic year, the grade for each of the courses will be recorded on the student's transcript, but only the higher of the two grades will be considered for the purpose of determining class rank and grade point average. For example, if a student takes a course and makes a "D" (1 point), and retakes the same class during the regular academic year and makes a "B" (3 points, unless weighted), both courses will appear on the student's transcript. Only the higher grade will be used to calculate class rank and grade point average.

When a student repeats a high school level course for credit in summer school, the grade for each of the courses will be recorded on the student's transcript and the average of the two grades will be used for the purpose of determining class rank and grade point average. For example, if a student takes a course and makes a "D" (1 point) and the student retakes the course during summer school for repeat credit and makes a "B" (3 points, unless weighted), both grades will be averaged to calculate class rank and grade point average.
