## Determining Class Rank

Classes of 2019, 2020. 2021

For purposes of determining class rank, Bristol Virginia Public Schools will use a grade point system. Students will earn the following points based on their course grades:

|  | Weighted Course |  |

| B | $\mathbf{4}$ points | $\mathbf{4}$ points |
| C | $\mathbf{3}$ points | $\mathbf{3}$ points |
| D | $\mathbf{1}$ point | $\mathbf{2}$ points |
|  |  | $\mathbf{1}$ point |

A total of points earned for all classes a student has taken, under the following guidelines, will comprise his/her grade point.

The number of high school credits accepted for class rank from a middle school program outside Bristol Virginia Public Schools will be limited to the number of high school credits offered at Virginia Middle School.

Transfer students may count only the number of courses toward class rank that students at Virginia Middle School and Virginia High School may count towards class rank. For the purpose of calculating Grade Point Average all classes on a transcript will count.

A maximum of eight (8) courses per year, taken during the regular school day will count toward class rank.

Class rank will be determined by the number of accrued points.
Grade point averages will include all courses taken and will still be computed for the purpose of reporting such information to colleges and prospective employers as requested by them.
